Dear Parent,

The Bucks County Department of Health in partnership with the New Hope-Solebury School District will be offering H1N1 vaccine free of charge to your child who is a student in the New Hope-Solebury School District at the **New Hope-Solebury High School located at 182 West Bridge Street, New Hope PA 18938 on Wednesday November 11, 2009 between the hours of 2pm and 6pm.** Vaccine will only be available for students in a school covered by the New Hope-Solebury School District. Any child who is not attending a school covered by the District will not receive a vaccination.

If possible, we will attempt to vaccinate high school students before the end of the school day. If you have a middle school or elementary school aged child, please bring your child to the high school on November 11th. We will not vaccinate your middle/elementary school aged child without you or another adult present.

If you have not yet returned a consent form and would like your child vaccinated, please complete and return the consent form as soon as possible to your school nurse. For those students who will require a second dose of the vaccine (those under 10 years of age), we will provide an opportunity to receive the second shot. The time and location of that clinic will follow.

Thank you for your patience and understanding, as the H1N1 vaccine has taken longer to produce and distribute than previously expected.
