Teacher Recommendations

- Ask at least two teachers who you have had in an academic subject area and who know you well.
- If a teacher is willing to write a letter of recommendation for you, then give them about three weeks to do so.
- Give the teachers a stamped, business sized envelope addressed to the college where you would like the letter to be sent. Also attach any teacher recommendation forms that the college requests.
- You will repeat the process for each of the schools to which you will be applying.
- Don't forget to send thank you notes to each of your teachers- remember that they are writing your recommendation letter as a courtesy :-)



College Admissions Process

- There is still time to take either the SAT or ACT for college admissions purposes

ACT

Test Date: December 12, 2009- Visit www.actstudent.org to register for the test.

SAT I and/or SAT II

Test Date: December 5, 2009- Visit www.collegeboard.com to register for the test

- Don't forget to fill out a "College Visitation Form" if you are going to be absent from school to visit a college. Forms can be obtained from the website and from the guidance office. Complete the form at least five school days prior to your visit and give it to your guidance counselor.
- Don't forget... it takes ten (10) school days for your guidance counselor to process your transcript request



form if you need a recommendation letter. If you turn your transcript request form in on November 24, 2009, then it will not be processed until December 11, 2009.

- Students who are considering athletics at a Division I or II institution are required to register with the NCAA Clearinghouse and regularly update your information with them. Go to www.ncaaclearinghouse.net for more information.
