



<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>g. Any other behavior or acts which has the effect of substantially interfering with a student's education, creates an intimidating or threatening educational environment, or substantially disrupts the orderly operations of the school.</p> <p>Complaints of bullying shall be investigated promptly, and corrective action shall be taken when a complaint is verified. Neither reprisals nor retaliation shall occur as a result of the submission of a complaint.</p> <p>The school district shall annually inform students that the bullying of students will not be tolerated.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall develop and promulgate an administrative regulation pertaining to bullying that does the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Delineate disciplinary consequences for bullying.</li><li>2. Identify staff person to receive reports of alleged bullying.</li><li>3. Define bullying to include acts that occur outside of a school setting if those acts, directed at another student, are severe, persistent and pervasive and have the effect of substantially interfering with a student's education, create a threatening environment, or substantially disrupting the operation of the school.</li><li>4.
