

SURVIVOR Field Day Guide-2009

Break out the sunscreen, the hats and sunglasses!
What? Vacation? No way- -it's time for...



That's right. May 29th is right around the corner. We've totally gone mad-Over 355 kids and an entire staff will take on the New Hope-Solebury Upper Elementary School on **Friday, May 29th for a day of fun!**

What do you have to do? Hey, we always save the good stuff for last. We take care of the set up, clean up and organizational end. You need to monitor students as they move from station to station (grass soccer fields & blacktop). Lunch will be served from 12-12:35 p.m. All students will eat outside. You need to report to lunch on time. **Lunch recess/quiet time will be in the classroom!**

Included with this packet is the list of challenges your students will participate in. Grade level tribes will travel together and participate in all the assigned challenges/activities. The ultimate goal of field day is to Outwit, Outplay, and Outlast your opponents.

When you arrive at each event, there will be officials to run the activity. Please help by making sure the tribe is ready to go. **In addition, we need your help in the discipline, teamwork, and sportsmanship area.**

General Notes

Please be at lunch on time and have your students leave at the appropriate time. During the day, your responsibility is to monitor students. **Make sure that each tribe is working together and not wondering off with members from another tribe.** There will be officials at each event throughout the day. If you have any questions, please ask the officials or Mr. DiTulio.

Please remember that the goal of the day is to have **FUN!!!** If you have a discrepancy with an official, rule, or question, please speak with the official away from the kids. Many of our officials do not do these games on a daily basis, so please bear with any errors that may occur. If the game can go on without giving an unfair advantage to one team and the calls are consistent, let's have some fun!!! All of the activities are adjusted to include all students, keep everyone involved, and help relax some of the 'killer' competitiveness. While it is hard to not get crazed and go for it all, kids will look to our reactions to any situations.

Guidelines for a Fun, Safe & comfortable Field Day!!!

"Dress for the weather"

1. Please wear comfortable shoes. No sandals, crocs, clogs or open-toe shoes.
2. Layer your clothes: T-shirt & shorts with sweatpants or wind pants, & a sweatshirt or light jacket. The grass is wet in the morning so you may want to bring an extra pair of socks or shoes.
3. Apply sunscreen (15 & above) at home before coming to school. Also, remember to bring sunscreen with you!
4. You may bring a small backpack to keep extra items in. (Water bottle, socks, sunglasses, sunscreen, etc.).

SURVIVOR Field Day-2009

Events

Station #1-Lava Race

All participate! In this event a huge volcano (Mt. Lion) has erupted in the tribes' camp. The lava is slowly pouring in and the tribes must escape. To do this they must use the buddy walkers to keep the lava from burning their feet. Each tribe will be split in half facing each other. The first two members from each tribe will travel to the cone, get off and go to the end of the other line. This process is repeated. Each tribe member will go once.

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 pt. for 2nd place

Station #2-Nitro Carry

All participate! A plane passing overhead has accidentally dropped toxic chemicals onto the camp site. Each tribe needs to use the Nitro Carry (mini parachute) to rid your camp of the waste. Six members from each tribe will run to the cone and put one toxic waste item on the Nitro Carry and return it to the waste container (hula-hoop). This process is repeated until all 5 items are retrieved. The next 6 members repeat the process until the entire team is finished.

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 point for 2nd place

Station #3-Tribe is Hungry

All participate! Food is limited on Survival Island. Tribes must get their food (small foam ball) from the tree to the basket trying not to drop any on the ground. Six members from each tribe will go at a time as they use bamboo poles (pvc pipe w/handles). This will be a timed event for 10 minutes. The tribe with the least amount of drops wins!

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 point for 2nd place

Station #4-Escape

All participate! The tribes have been captured by another tribe and they have tied their legs together so they must figure out a way to escape. This is a 3-legged race using a double potato sack. On the signal to begin, the first two tribe members from each tribe will hop down to the cone and back. This process is repeated until all tribe members have gone one time.

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 point for 2nd place

Station #5-Frogs in the Pond

All participate! Each tribe has one frog and one hula hoop. Poly spots (Lily pads) are scattered around a wading pool (pond). On the signal to begin, the 1st player from each tribe runs up to a lily pad and stands on it. Players will then attempt to throw their frog **UNDERHAND** into the pond. If they are successful, they grab their frog and lily pad and bring it back to their team. If they are unsuccessful, they grab only the frog and give it to the next player. All collected lily pads go into the team hula hoop. When all the lily pads are gone, the game is over. Each team adds up their lily pads. The team with the most lily pads wins.

Scoring: 2 points for the winning team; 1 point for 2nd place

Station #6-Fire Drill

All participate! Your campfire has gotten out of control. All you have is one bucket to put out the flames. On the signal to begin, the first player from each tribe goes to the water source (55

gallon recycling bucket), fills up the bucket and brings it back to the line. The tribe passes the bucket to the end trying not to let any water spill. The last player empties the water into another bucket at the end of the line, runs the bucket to the front and fills it and starts the bucket moving again. The first tribe to fill the bucket to the fill line wins!

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 point for 2nd place

Station #7-Duel Game

All participate! DUEL is a game of balance, strategy and skill, not strength. One player from each tribe stands on a platform and holds an end of the rope in one hand. Only one hand may be on the rope when in the starting position. When the tribe official calls "DUEL" each player reels in the rope in an aggressive hand-over-hand method until the rope becomes taught. The goal is to topple the opponent with the use of the rope. Each group will have three chances. The player that wins 2 out of 3 chances earns 1 point for their tribe. The tribe that finishes with the most points wins!

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 point for 2nd place

Station #8-Coconut Bowling

All participate! On Survivor Island the ground is dried and hard from the volcanic rock. Now you must pass the test of strength. The object is to knock over bowling pins using a real coconut instead of a bowling ball. On the signal to begin, both players from each tribe will attempt to knock over as many pins as possible. The tribe the knocks over more pins earns a point. Each tribe member will go once.

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 point for 2nd place

Station #9-Catch-N-Release

All participate! When you are stranded on an Island for 39 days, you need to find whatever you can to eat. The river is a great place to fish and give the tribe members a rich source of protein. Each tribe will be split in half and will line up behind the cone. One line will throw the fish and the other line will attempt to catch the fish in aluminum fishing nets. The thrower and catcher will switch lines after each attempt. Every fish that is caught counts as a point for that tribe. Both tribes must stay behind the white line while throwing and catching. This is a timed event for 10 minutes. The tribe that catches the most fish wins!

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 point for 2nd place

Station #10-Survival Obstacle Course

All participate! This is the ultimate test of strength and endurance. With a limited supply of food on the Island, tribe members are weak after brutal challenges. Tribe members will be tested going through the obstacle course which includes climbing the cliffs (rock wall), Mt. Lion (cargo net), hurdles, agility ladder, and much more. Each tribe will start on opposite sides of the rock wall. A tribal leader will start the challenge and stagger their starts. Every tribe member will complete the obstacle course. The tribe that finishes first wins!

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 point for 2nd place

Station #11-River Rafting

All participate! Teamwork will be the key for this challenge. Each tribe must successfully get to the base of the river. The easiest way to do that is to build a raft and float down the river. On the signal to begin, two members from each tribe will kneel on the raft (2 scooters connected) and

paddle around the cone and back. Every tribe member will go once. The tribe that finishes first wins!

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 point for 2nd place

Station #12-The Running Man

All participate! The Running Man is a fun way to exercise the wrists and forearms while integrating cooperation and teamwork. Players must communicate and work together to make the man run. This is a relay type activity. Each tribe will line up facing a teammate (roughly 5 ft. apart from each other). Player #1 will have all of their cord out and player #2 will have the cord wound up all the way to the running man. This will be the start up for each team. On the signal to begin, player #1 will wind cord in while player #2 stays in a stationary position as they unwind. Player #2 must actually unwind line and NOT let line out by allowing the handle to spin by itself. When tribes are lined up and either winding or unwinding it looks like the "Running Man" is actually racing against the other tribe. Upon completion, pass to next player in line until the entire tribe is finished. The tribe that finishes first wins!

Scoring: 2 points for the winning tribe; 1 point for 2nd place

Survivor Maze

All participate! This maze is just for fun and points will not be awarded at this station. Created by Dan Kling, the survivor maze will have you thinking as you weave through the twists and turns. Be careful, don't get lost!

SURVIVOR FIELD DAY-2009

BACKGROUND: Our "Survivor" Field Day is designed to take place during the morning and afternoon for a total of 355 students. The purpose is to provide children with the opportunity to use the teamwork and leadership skills they learned in our cooperative learning unit in a real situation. This event is the culmination of a cooperative games and challenges unit and was based on the TV show "Survivor". Each grade level will be divided into 6 tribes for a total of 18 tribes for grades 3, 4, and 5. Each tribe will be responsible for making a tribal flag and learning a tribal dance the morning of FD. All students will report to homeroom for attendance/lunch count. **At 9 a.m. students will meet their tribe members at base camp (designated classroom in their wing) and will have 20 minutes to complete a tribal flag & learn a tribal dance. All materials for making a flag will be in each base camp.**

OPENING CEREMONY: Our Opening Ceremony will consist of the following:

- Procession of Tribes to tribal Council (gym)
- Tribal music performed by Mr. Sasala
- Welcome by Mr. DiTulio
- Star Spangled Banner performed Mr. Sasala
- Recognition of participating tribes including the flag bearer
- (In this order: 3rd Grade Tribes: Alinta, Bula Bula, Viveros, Yasur, Timbira, Barramundi; 4th Grade Tribes: Saboga, Motomaji, Pagong, Boran, Moto, Rarotonga; 5th Grade Tribes: Forza, Puka Puka, Nobag, Tambaqui, Balboa, Gitanos)
- Survivor Oath led by Bradley Nuemann
- Let the Games begin!

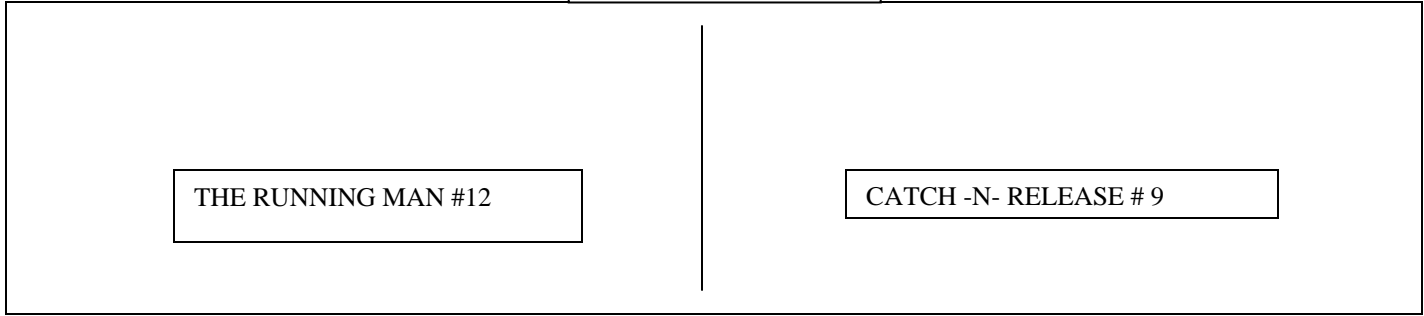
