The school newspaper allows students to publish their own writing. It gives them a chance to write about what interests them and to take charge of the content of the newspaper. The newspaper has an editorial staff of fifth graders who meet every Friday at recess. This group brainstorms ideas for articles and features they feel would be of interest to the student body. They write copy and design layout. When all articles are completed and typed and comics are drawn, an issue is published. The number of students in attendance varies on any given Friday. The editorial staff is always looking for new members. No experience is necessary.

All students in grades three, four and five are invited to submit articles to the paper for publication. Students should be sure to place their name and class on any articles they submit. A basket designated for the paper sits outside the main office at all times. Announcements are made periodically in the morning asking for student articles. A request for articles is also advertised in the paper. Students may place articles in the basket any day of the week and the editorial staff will read them, type them, and keep them for the next publication.
