We would like to remind everyone of...

## New Hope-Solebury Upper Elementary School's Attendance Policy:

1. The school day begins at 8:40 am. All students are expected to be in their classrooms ready to work at this time.
2. Chronic absences are deemed as 10 or more days in the school year.
3. In case of absences, Call the school's absence line at (215) 862-8193.

<b>Students who are <u>ABSENT</u>:</b>	<b>Students who are <u>TARDY</u> (arrive after the 8:45 am bell or leave school before the dismissal bell)</b>
