


33" wide by 85" tall is the

RULES AND INFO

Labeling

Please label your work clearly so we know if kids did it by themselves or if the whole family helped. We would like to give out awards for each category. Example below

“Johnny Smith - 4N”—this indicates that student(s) did all the work except for using sharp cutting tools, hot glue, etc.

“The Smith Family - 4N”—this indicates parents and kids worked on it together

Judging

Judges will be looking for various qualities in the work. Craftsmanship, Effort, Resourcefulness, School Spirit, Unique, Charm, Is it Homemade?

Award Certificates and prizes will be given out for different categories as well as an overall winner

Specs

Size—Obstacles can be as small as a shoebox up to the size of a tub.

It must be able to fit through a doorway!!!

33” wide by 85” tall is the size of the door at the UES. If it is too big it will be disqualified

Must be light and sturdy enough for an adult to easily carry.

Must be completely assembled upon arrival. You will not have time to do any last minute adjustments when you drop off.

Drop Off/Pick Up

We are having just one K-5 Field Day this year so do not bring your obstacles to the Lower Elementary. All works should go to the UES this year.

Drop off will be staggered to alleviate congestion in the UES office. Please adhere to your drop off day if possible. LES students should drop off on Monday, May 20. UES Students— Tuesday May 21.

Drop off times each day are **7:45-8:15a; 9:00a-3:15p; 3:45-4:45p**. You can go through the main entrance, go through raptor security (have a photo ID) and drop it off outside the gymnasium.

DO NOT DROP OFF FROM 8:15-9AM OR 3:15-3:45. Arrival and dismissal times are too congested.

Please pick up after Field Day is over at your earliest convenience.
