Below are areas of Science that students could choose from for their project:

- **Life Science**: Scientific study of living organism, like plants, animals, human beings.
- **Physical Science**: Area of study of the physical world around you that includes non-living systems, such as chemistry and physics.
- **Earth and Space Science**: Study of Earth and space, including our planet's physical characteristics. Areas include geology, meteorology, oceanography, and astronomy.
- **Engineering or Technology**: Engineering is the process of creating and building structures, products, and systems by using math and science. Technology is the use of knowledge to invent new devices or tools.
