

Dear Dr. Charles Lentz (*Superintendent*), Mrs. Liz Sheehan (*Board President*), and Dr. Charles Malone (*Director of Education*),

We, the current students, alumni, parents, and community of New Hope-Solebury School District, are writing to you regarding what we feel are the insufficient ways in which systemic racism is currently being addressed in New Hope-Solebury's curricula and culture.

While the [District's June 2 letter](#) to the parents was well intentioned, it failed to outline how these issues would be addressed on a day-to-day basis. The District's current plan for No Place for Hate is [not the first iteration of this program to be implemented in our school](#), and lacks a clear plan to spur action and awareness in our community. Moreover, the choice to send the letter solely to the parents, instead of making it available on the district's website, has created ambiguity for alumni and community members over the district's stance on systemic racism and white supremacy. To express our disappointment surrounding the district's lack of concrete action, we are calling on New Hope-Solebury to address the community with a detailed plan of actionable steps taking into account our four requests, detailed below.

New Hope-Solebury has played an important role in providing a safe and encouraging place for us to grow as students and world citizens. We each have had our lives positively impacted by the care of hardworking teachers and staff who opened our minds to a range of issues, fields, and passions. However, this has all occurred within the confines of what we refer to as the "New Hope Bubble." In a district that is [92% white](#), meaningful engagement with racial issues is rare while frequent microaggressions and more [overt racist acts](#) are not uncommon. There is a deficiency in our classrooms regarding education on issues of structural, institutional, individual, and systemic racism. **Thus, we are calling for action to be made in the existing curricula and culture, for this action to be overseen by a committee that is responsible and responsive to all stakeholders in the District, and a public statement released by the district committing to lasting change.**

We know that this proposal is the beginning of an ongoing conversation between our administration, community, and student body. **The basis of justice, equity, and change begins with a properly educated and informed generation.** We propose the following list of tangible actions:

**A change in curriculum that:**

- a. Actively combats inherent bias and systemic racism by engaging with, and educating through, the non-White perspective in history, literature, and art.
- b. Seeks to correct the underrepresentation of Black, Indigenous and people of color (BIPOC) as leaders, writers, artists, and thinkers.
- c. Assigns works from viewpoints that examine whiteness and privilege.
- d. Utilizes Social Studies courses to address not only our country's foundational history of white supremacy, but also the enduring effects these systems maintain in modern America.
  - i. While our history curriculum examines slavery and the Civil Rights movement, the conversation rarely extends beyond the 1960's and into the purview of modern-day institutional racism, police brutality, and mass incarceration.

- e. Utilizes Reading and Language Arts (RELA) courses to expose students to literature and poetry written by BIPOC.
  - i. These works should not just encapsulate moments of hardship and strife for their writers, but also celebrate the pride and diversity that emerge from distinct cultures and ethnicities.
  - ii. Specific writers that could be added to the curriculum include, but are not limited to, James Baldwin, Audre Lorde, Angela Davis, Michelle Alexander, Bryan Stevenson, Robin DiAngelo, Maya Angelou, Jericho Brown, Gregory Pardlo, Alex Haley, James McBride, etc.
- f. Emphasizes the many contributions BIPOC have made in the fields of both classical and contemporary art and music.
  - i. The lessons must contextualize the historical, cultural, and political implications necessary for understanding.
  - ii. Specific musicians and artists that could be added include Kehinde Wiley, Jacob Lawrence, Basquiat, Billie Holiday, Ray Charles, Duke Ellington, William Grant Still, Ella Fitzgerald, Jeremy O. Harris, August Wilson, Audra McDonald, Abbie Mitchell, Bob Cole, etc.

**A change in culture** that:

- a. Engages in continued education of why systemic racism and white supremacy pervades every part of our daily lives and how students can acknowledge and combat such systems of oppression.
- b. Encourages the student body to take an active approach to discussing the difficult topics of race and racism in the United States.
  - i. This includes hosting guest speakers for regular workshops and assemblies, training counselors to effectively support minority students, and providing resources for parents to continue the conversation about race at home.
- c. Within faculty and administration, engages in twice yearly implicit bias, communication strategies, and anti-racism training and provides information on the facilitator, timing, and content of this training to the public.
- d. Creates a titled administrative position that focuses specifically on general diversity and inclusivity with regards to pay, administrative support, and school-wide culture.
- e. Encourages a diversity of races, backgrounds, and voices as staff, teachers, and board members. Human Resources should reach out to Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) when seeking applicants for full-time teaching and administrative positions.

**The creation of a committee** that:

- a. Oversees the implementation of anti-racism into the District's curriculum and culture.
  - i. This committee should provide regular updates and interface with the community of New Hope-Solebury to ensure continued progress and effort on realizing the district's goals of racial equity.

The release of **public, detailed statement** that:

- a. Acknowledges the district's stance on white supremacy and systemic racism.
- b. Commits to evaluating the shortcomings of current curricula and school culture and making an equitable and diverse educational experience the district's top priority.
- c. Commits to specific, tangible action with concrete timelines that act in accordance with the demands above.

We appreciate you taking the time to review our position and hope this letter will prompt a timely and thoughtful response. By implementing these necessary and overdue changes, we believe that the New Hope-Solebury School District would be living up to its mission of engaging, enriching, and empowering students through an education that is aware of the realities that exist within our small town and the world at large.
