Science

Please label one folder “Science,” or label one section in accordion folder “Science.”

Social Studies

Please label one folder “SS,” or label one section in accordion folder “SS.”

French & Spanish

French: 1 notebook and a folder, or one tab in the accordion-style folder
Spanish: a folder

Reading - only for students taking Reading

Composition notebook or spiral for a journal and 1 pocket folder

Specials

Pocket Folder and 1 spiral notebook
