

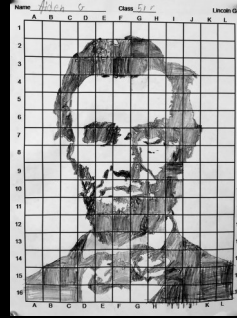

Students have worked on a variety of projects this year. In the fall, students deconstructed an image based off the ideas of the Mexican artist *Damián Ortega*. After that they had a choice of projects to complete: self portrait using the *OSMO Masterpiece* app, one and two point perspective drawings, grid drawings, oil pastel landscapes, 3D printing designs on *Blokify*, Animation using the *Loop* app, creating stop motion videos and green screen technology images. There will be live demonstrations of some of these in the hallway this year during the art show so you can see what it is like in art class. Also, Ms. Van Praag will have the Naturals perform live.
