We would like to thank our students and staff for the cooperation they have demonstrated throughout the project to this point.

Updates:

- ✓ Over the winter break, there will be a great deal of electrical work done on the project. The District will see several power outages over the break while the work is occurring. Toward the end of the break, all facets of the District will be operational again, and sports practices, etc., will resume.
- ✓ Air quality testing will continue to ensure the safety of our students and staff. To date, all air quality test results have been normal. Additionally, we have had the New Hope Fire Department in several times to test for gasses, such as Carbon Monoxide, in the air. Again, these results have been negative. We will continue to test the air quality of both the HS and MS on an ongoing basis.
- ✓ As a reminder, all contractors and other workers are required to submit background clearances to the District. This safety measure has been put into place since the beginning of the project to ensure that workers meet the qualifications for being on our school grounds.
